I won't be able to touch the giraffes as I could scare them.

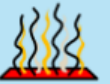
I can touch the skull and neck bones.

Then I will be able to watch the animals eat the food I cut up.

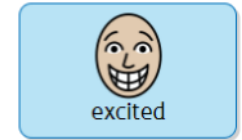
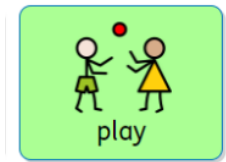


Enrichment

I can watch the animals play with them after.

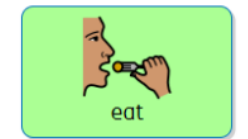


Pellet Dissection
